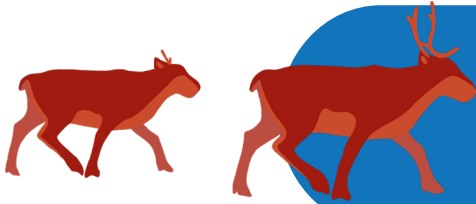


Canada in a Changing Climate

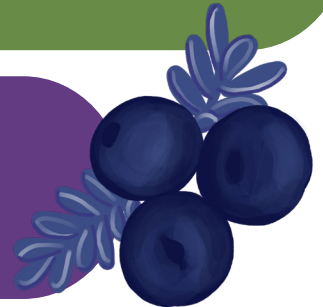
Indigenous Peoples have unique strengths for responding to environmental and climate changes
